

Top tips for sitting your remote session exams



Before you book your exam



Ensure the computer you will use on exam day meets our **minimum technical specifications**

Read and understand the **Student Information Sheet**

Study in the same location, with the same connection and equipment you will use on exam day

Use a personal computer. If using a corporate laptop, ensure there are no firewalls or security settings that may prevent the exam software from running

Use a WIRED internet connection to avoid any connection disruptions



After booking and before exam day

Contact Us today to withdraw before your exam day

Download, install and test the iX Exam Delivery software on Google Chrome after you receive your Token ID, 5 days before your exam

Attend the ATA Student Trial Day for information about check-in, set-up and more.
Install the YouXun app first on PC and mobile here

Avoid upgrading or changing your software after successfully completing the web system test

Fully reboot your PC the day before your exam. This will reset your applications



On exam day



Set up your workspace before you login. **View our desk set-up here**

Launch the YouXun app 30 minutes before your exam start time

Launch the iX Exam Delivery software 30 minutes before your exam start time

Bring a calculator. Scientific calculators are NOT provided on the exam platform

Connect to a power source throughout the full exam

NO scrap paper is permitted. Use onscreen scratch pad

Don't Close the YouXun or Examinar applications



After exam completed



Uninstall the exam software once you've exited the exam

Sitting multiple remote exams?
You'll need to reinstall the software again

Make sure you enter the correct Token ID for each exam
